Notice of AGM.

Committee Nominations.

Trustees.

Spring Working Party

The spring working party is planned for 24th/25th April this year. We expect to have delivery of hedging shrubs just before the weekend and one of the working party tasks will be to plant them. If there is any doubt about the weather, members should phone Trevor to check whether the date is being changed, especially if they are making a long journey to attend. If you cannot attend on the working party

weekend, it is quite acceptable to do a specific task at a more convenient time; please phone Ray if you wish to arrange this.

Please make sure someone records your presence at the working party as the usual charge for not attending will be made.

Working on Boats.

As spring is coming and it will be time to do all those boat repairs we have been putting off, just a reminder - no noisy work may be done at the moorings unless it is done at the cemetery end of the site. If you intend to do any noisy work, please observe the agreed hours of work and arrange with Ray to move your boat to the appropriate part of the site. No noisy work may be done on Sundays.
