Notice of AGM.

Trustees.

The terms of the lease require us to have at least two trustees and not more than four. There are currently three trustees and hence one vacancy. Please let the committee know if you would like to be a trustee.

Any items of business or questions for the AGM should be notified in writing to a committee member at least 14 days before the AGM.

Fees for 2006.

The fees for 2006 have gone up by approx 3% in line with inflation. If you are paying by Standing Order, please send in the form as soon as possible because we have to send it on to your Bank in time for them to process it.

Boat Licences.

All members should be aware of the rule requiring boats to be licensed through the club. Members who have not complied with this rule should expect to receive a bill for an amount equal to the lost commission of 5% of the licence fee. Members whose boats remain unlicensed without good cause are liable to be expelled from the Club.

Please note that Franco has taken on boat licensing; your application form with all supporting documents, must be sent to him before the due date for you to receive the 10% prompt payment discount.

Notice Period.

If you are thinking of moving your boat from the Club, please give as much notice as possible. The mooring agreement requires 3 months' notice; members leaving without giving this notice are liable for 3 months' mooring fees in lieu of notice.
